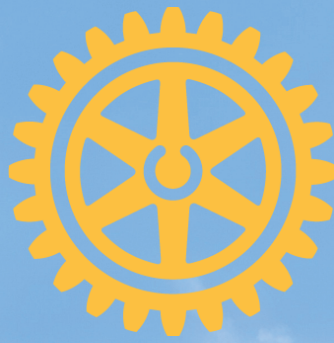

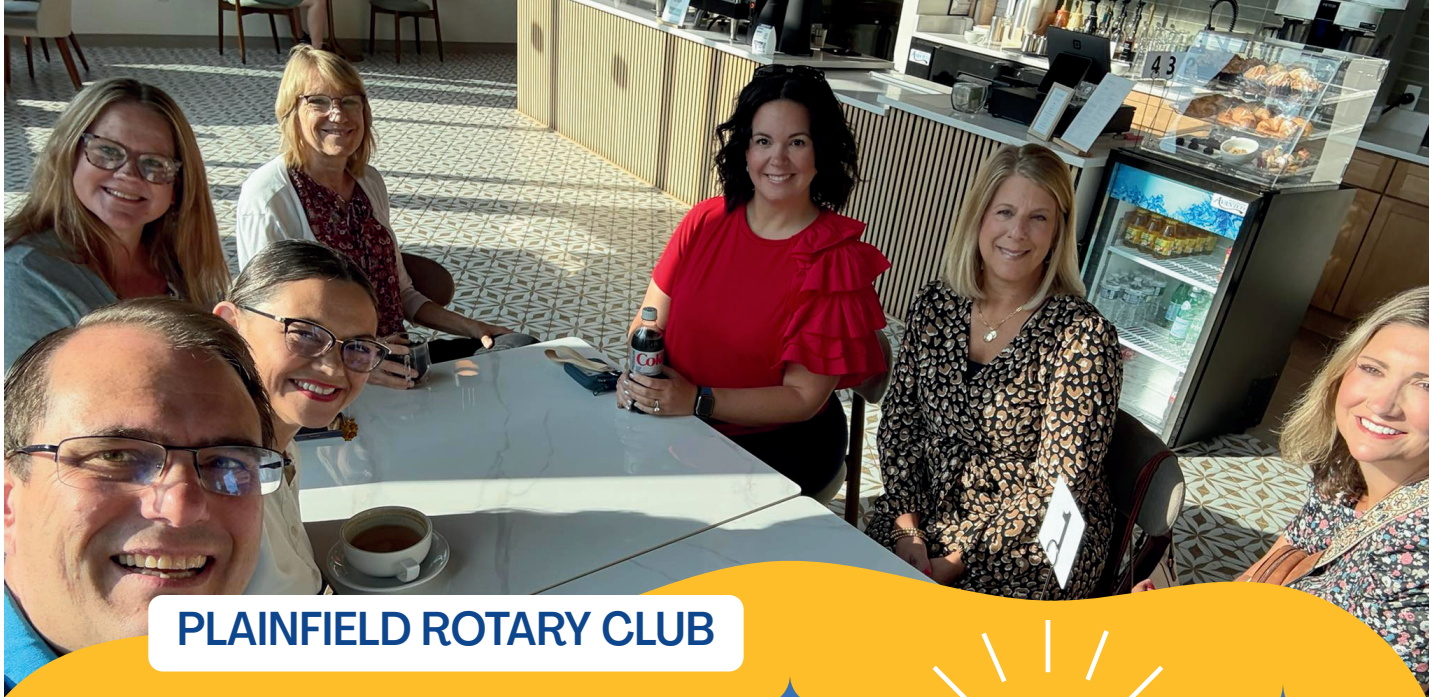

Brentwood Elementary Book Vending Machine

Plainfield Rotary helped bring a book vending machine to Brentwood Elementary to reward students for positive behavior, academic achievement, and participation in reading initiatives. Students earn tokens they use to select and keep a book of their own, increasing book ownership and encouraging reading beyond the classroom. This project helps ensure every child has access to high-quality books, regardless of economic background, and creates a lasting incentive for literacy.

ROTARY'S FOUNDATION

Rotary was founded in 1905 by Chicago lawyer Paul Harris, who believed professionals could strengthen their communities through fellowship and service. For more than a century, Rotary has united people across cultures and borders to turn shared values into lasting action.

ROTARY'S GLOBAL IMPACT

Rotary is a leading partner in the Global Polio Eradication Initiative, helping reduce polio cases by 99.9% and protecting more than 3 billion children through vaccinations. Beyond polio, Rotary funds sustainable projects in education, clean water, health, economic development, and peacebuilding in communities around the world.

From the earliest days of the organization, Rotarians were concerned with promoting high ethical standards in their professional lives. One of the world's most widely printed and quoted statements of business ethics is The Four-Way Test, which was created in 1932 by Rotarian Herbert J. Taylor when he was asked to take charge of a company that was facing bankruptcy.

This 24-word test for employees to follow in their business and professional lives became the guide for sales, production, advertising, and all relations with dealers and customers, and the survival of the company is credited to this simple philosophy. Adopted by Rotary in 1943, The Four-Way Test has been translated into more than a hundred languages and published in thousands of ways.





The History of Rotary

“ Whatever Rotary may mean to us, to the world it will be known by the results it achieves. - Paul Harris

Rotary started with the vision of one man – Paul Harris. The Chicago attorney formed the Rotary Club of Chicago on 23 February 1905, so professionals with diverse backgrounds could exchange ideas and form meaningful, lifelong friendships.

Over time, Rotary’s reach and vision gradually extended to humanitarian service. Members have a long track record of addressing challenges in their communities and around the world.

That commitment endures today through an organization that remains truly international. Only 16 years after being founded, Rotary had clubs on six continents. Our members now span the globe, working to solve some of our world’s most challenging problems.

We’re not afraid to dream big and set bold goals. We began our fight against polio in 1979 with a project to immunize 6 million children in the Philippines. Today, polio remains endemic in only two countries – down from 125 in 1988.

With every project, we’re changing the world for the better.

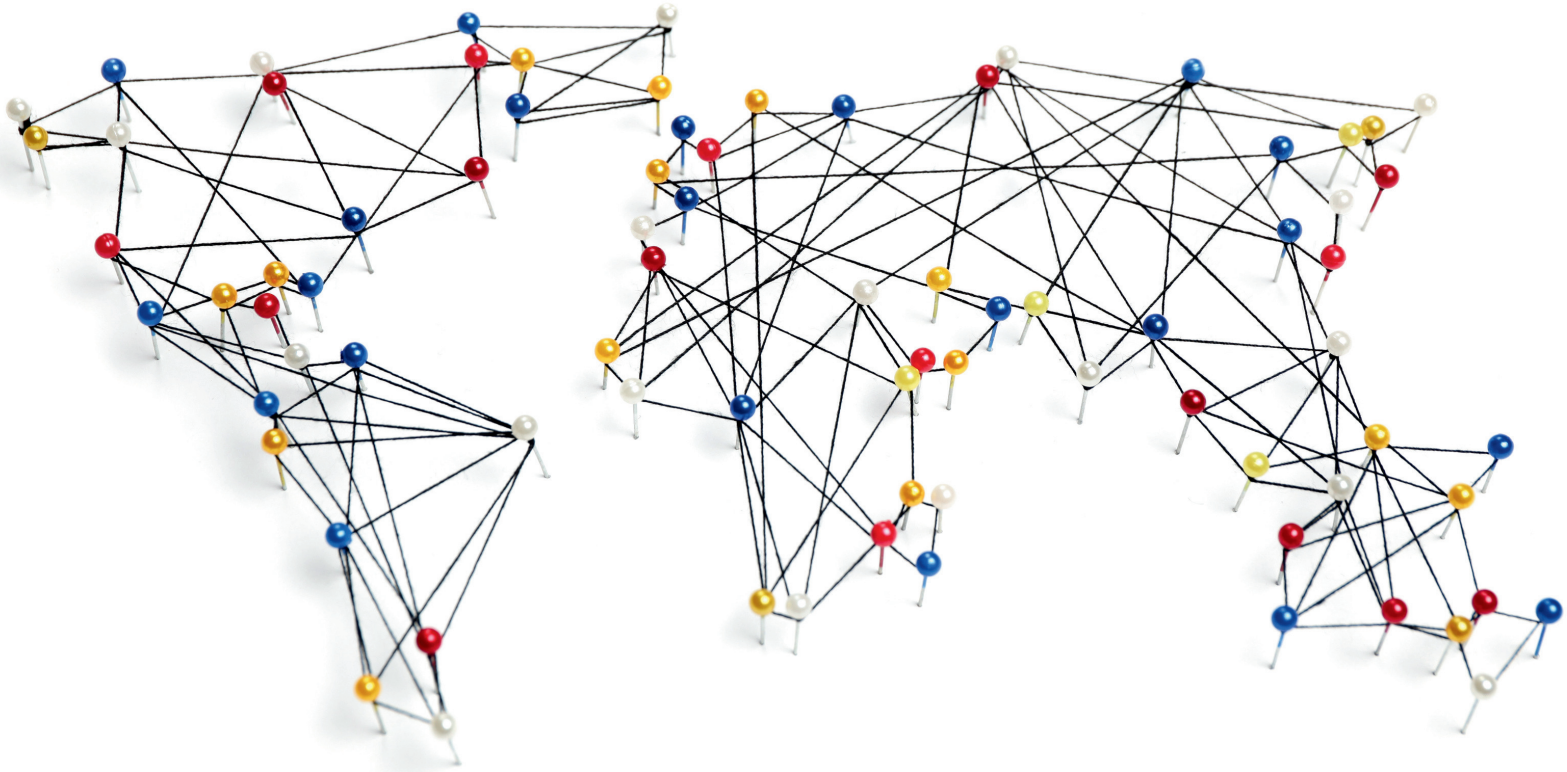
